Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission schedules first meeting on Sept. 5

ST. MICHAELS, Ariz. — The Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission has scheduled its first commissioners meeting at 10 a.m. on Friday, Sept. 5, at their office located at 29 Crest Road in St. Michaels, Ariz.

The recently established commission is an unprecedented program of the Navajo Nation that will investigate incidences of civil rights infractions that will protect the Navajo people from being discriminated, especially for Navajo residents who live in border towns. In addition, their role will be broad as they gear up to advocate in state, national and international arenas.

The current commissioners include Clarence Chee, Steven A. Darden, Irving Gleason and Duane "Chili" Yazzie.
