Judiciary Committee's new developments postpone public hearing for Chief Justice Herb Yazzie to April 13

WINDOW ROCK, Ariz. – The public hearing scheduled on Tuesday, March 9 regarding the work performance of Navajo Chief Justice Herb Yazzie of the Navajo Nation Supreme Court has been rescheduled to Tuesday, April 13 by the Judiciary Committee of the 21st Navajo Nation Council.

New developments occurred during the Judiciary Committee's regular scheduled meeting on Thursday, March 4, as officials voted in favor to postpone the hearing.

The public hearing is now scheduled for Tuesday, April 13, at 10:00 am. The hearing will take place at the Navajo Nation Museum, Highway 264 and Loop Road, Window Rock, Ariz. 86515.

The evaluation period covers the period from Jan. 1, 2009 to Dec. 31, 2009.

The public is strongly encouraged to express their written comment, their concerns or their recommendations of Yazzie's qualifications, character and his work performance.
