Order Requesting Supplemental Briefs in the Case of Nelson v. Shirley, Case No. SC-CV-03-10

As a result of the enactment of Resolution CJA-08-10, the Navajo Nation Supreme Court is requesting supplemental briefs and has revised the briefing schedule and date of oral argument in the above numbered matter. According to the attached Orders and to accommodate amicus curiae (friend of the court), the schedule is now as follows:

1. Appellant's reply to Appellee's Answering Brief remains as is and shall be filed on March 9, 2010 at 5 p.m.
2. Appellant and Appellee shall file their supplemental briefs by 5:00 p.m., Friday, April 02, 2010.
3. The amicus brief originally set for March 05, 2010 has been changed to 5:00 p.m., Friday, April 02, 2010 and shall include, if any, the issue on the impact of the new legislation under Resolution CJA-08-10.
4. Appellant and Appellee shall file their response briefs to the supplemental brief by 5:00 p.m., Friday, April 09, 2010.
5. The amicus response by the Appellant and Appellee set for March 10, 2010 has been changed to 5:00 p.m., Friday, April 09, 2010.
6. There shall be no reply by either party.
7. The oral argument set for March 12, 2010 has been rescheduled to Tuesday, April 20, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. at Navajo Nation Museum, Window Rock, Navajo Nation.
8. The amicus brief, supplemental briefs and response briefs shall be limited to no more than thirty (30) pages.
