February 13, 2019: Probate and Quiet Title

February 20, 2019: Validation of common law marriage; recognition of traditional marriage; dissolution of marriage; paternity, child support, custody or visitation; modification of child support, custody or visitation; how to answer a petition.

February 27, 2019: Guardianship of a minor

March 6, 2019: Name change; correction of record; declaration of a name.
