## Navajo Nation Council Special Session on March 23

**WINDOW ROCK, Ariz.** – The 22<sup>nd</sup> Navajo Nation Council will convene on March 23 at 10:00 a.m. at the Navajo Nation Council Chamber for a Special Session.

On the proposed agenda are four legislations dealing with confirmations and two reports.

Legislation 0073-12, sponsored by Council Delegate Walter Phelps (Cameron, Coalmine Canyon, Leupp, Tolani Lake, Tsidi To ii), seeks to confirm the appointment of Larry Curley as the Division Director of the Navajo Nation Division of Health.

The Council will also consider the following nominees for the Navajo Government Development Commission: Andrew Curley for the Health, Education, and Human Services Committee (legislation 0014-12); Martha Davis for Diné College (legislation 0040-12); and Richie Nez for the Fort Defiance Agency Council (legislation 0041-12).

According to 2 N.N.C. § 972(A), “The Commission shall consist of 12 Navajo members to be confirmed by and serve at the pleasure of the Navajo Nation Council...”

If confirmed by Council, Curley, Davis, and Nez will each fill one of twelve positions on the Navajo Government Development Commission.

The first report will be given by Stanley Pollack and Kate Hoover, both with the Navajo Nation Department of Justice, on Navajo Nation water rights.

The second report will be given by Apache County Sherriff Joe Dedman.
