Naa' bik'iyati' Committee to meet on the eve of Thanksgiving

WINDOW ROCK, Ariz. – On November 23, 2011, the Naa' bik'iyati' Committee of the 22nd Navajo Nation Council will have a meeting at the Navajo Nation Council Chamber at 1:00 pm.

The Committee will consider the following legislations during their meeting:

Legislation 0403-11, sponsored by Honorable Dwight Witherspoon, will approve and authorize the Navajo Nation Office of Scholarship and Financial Assistance (Department of Dine Education) to enter into a P.L. 93-638 Higher Education Program Contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to P.L. 93-638, as amended, for a three-year term beginning January 1, 2012. The legislation is related to the following committees: Health, Education and Human Services; Budget and Finance; and Naa' bik'iyati' Committee.

Legislation 0414-11, sponsored by Honorable Lorenzo Curley, amends Title 11 of the Navajo Nation Code by changing the primary election date of the Navajo Nation elections. The legislation is related to the following committees: Law and Order; Naa' bik'iyati'; and the Navajo Nation Council.

Legislation 0394-11, sponsored by Honorable Duane Tsinigine, will amend the Navajo Nation Code Title 18, Chapter 12, to provide protection, health, and safety for the Navajo Nation people in the transportation of uranium ore over and across Navajo Nation land. The legislation is related to the following committees: Law and Order; Resources and Development; and Naabik'iyati'.

Legislation 0398-11, sponsored by Honorable Jonathan L. Hale, enacts Title 9, §§1901-1925 to enact the Navajo Nation Vulnerable Adult Protection Act of 2011. The legislation is related to the following committees: Health, Education and Human Services; Law and Order; and Naabik'iyati'.

Legislation 0408-11, sponsored by Honorable Walter Phelps, would enact the Navajo Nation Worker's Compensation Act of 2011. The legislation is related to the following committees: Budget & Finance; and Naa' bik'iyati'.
