NNHRC to meet about redistricting with Arizona representatives

ST. MICHAELS, Ariz.— The Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission will meet with Arizona representatives about redistricting efforts on Wednesday, July 20, 2011, at 1:30 p.m. at the Navajo Nation Museum in conference room 3 in Window Rock, Navajo Nation, (Arizona).

Members, who will be at the meeting, include:, Arizona Senator Jack Jackson, Jr., Arizona Representative Albert Hale, Arizona Representative Tom Chabin, Hopi Tribal Representative Marshall Nimmingha, City of Flagstaff Government Relations Specialist Daryl Melvin, and invited county officials and representatives from the San Carlos Apache Nation and White Mountain Apache Nation.

For the Navajo Nation, representatives, who will be at the meeting, include: NNHRC Commissioners, NNHRC staff members, Navajo Board of Election Supervisors members, Jarvis Williams for the Office of the Navajo Nation Speaker, Heather Anderson for the Office of the Navajo Nation President, Michelle Begay for the Navajo Nation Department of Justice.

The main topics will be about voting district boundaries for Arizona congressional and legislative districts and counties.

Senator Jack Jackson is hosting the meeting with the NNHRC. All interested parties are encouraged to attend.

The meeting is open to the public.
