Open House at NNHRC about Arizona Redistricting

ST. MICHAELS, Ariz.—The Navajo Nation Human Rights Commission will host an open house for those interested in submitting an electronic public input form to the Arizona Independent Redistricting Commission about the approved congressional and legislative draft maps on **Thursday, November 3, 2011 from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m.**, at its office located in the Apache housing sub-division at 29 Crest Road in St. Michaels, Navajo Nation (Arizona). Refreshments will be provided.

NNHRC staff members will provide an overview about redistricting in Arizona and will provide individuals an opportunity to access the www.azredistricting.org website to submit a public input form.

Redistricting occurs nationwide every 10 years after the release of the decennial census data and is the process of redrawing voting district boundaries based on new census data population shifts so that each district is equal in population size.

To learn more and to actively participate in the Arizona redistricting process, attend the open house. The last date to submit public input to AIRC is November 5, 2011.
