PRESIDENT BEGAYE APPROVES STIPENDS FOR GRAZING OFFICIALS IN RESOLUTION CJA-2-16

WINDOW ROCK-Regarding Resolution CJA-2-16, President Russell Begaye approved appropriations for stipends for grazing officials but line-item vetoed a total amount of \$854,840 in Exhibit C, Section 2, for expenses that were more operational than what could be defined as "stipends".

The justification President Begaye set forth addressed how the resolution's appropriation for stipends included expenses outside of what "stipends" are defined as, which is generally a fixed sum such as a salary or allowance.

In the resolution, the appropriation for stipends also included travel expenses, conference fees and expenses, supplies and mileage. Amounts such as these were line-item vetoed.

Both President Begaye and Vice President Nez are considering a moratorium on all Undesignated, Unreserved Funds (UUF) in consideration of how current oil prices are impacting the budget.

"We must all be more frugal and prudent in our spending," President said in his justification. "This means less travel and conferences for all the Executive Branch."

Resolution CJA-2-16 sought approval for supplemental funding from the UUF in the total amount of \$1,786,340, for stipends for the District Grazing Committee, Eastern Navajo Land Board and Major Irrigation Farm Bards.



Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. 1005 (C)(10), action for Legislation CJA-2-16 is being submitted to the Navajo Nation Council, through the Office of the Speaker within the ten (10) days requirement. Furthermore, the Navajo Nation President has line item veto authority for budget items within the annual Navajo Nation Comprehensive Budget or Supplemental appropriations, which are not subject to override by the Navajo Nation Council. 2 N.N.C. 164(A)(17).

After careful consideration and consultation with the Divisions, I have decided to exercise my line item veto and line-item veto the following items in **Exhibit "C" under SECTION 2.: APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,786,340.00 FOR STIPENDS FOR THE DISTRICT GRAZING COMMITTEE, EASTERN NAVAJO LAND BOARD AND MAJOR IRRIGATION FARM BOARDS**

The total amount line-item vetoed is \$854,840.00. The justification for use of the President's line-item veto is set forth below.

The Resolution is approval for "stipends" for District Grazing Officials, Eastern Navajo Land Board and Major Irrigation Farm Boards to attend Chapter meetings. A stipend is generally a fixed sum such as a salary or allowance. However, in the Detailed Budget form the appropriation is beyond generally what "stipends" are defined.

The appropriation includes travel expenses; conference fees and expenses; supplies; and mileage. These are classified as more operational expenses, which are beyond what the Resolution approves as its supplement request for "stipends". As stated in a recent Navajo Hopi Land Commission meeting, the Vice-President and I are considering a moratorium on all Undesignated, Unreserved funds, until we know how the current oil prices will impact our budget this next coming fiscal year. In the interim, we all must be more frugal and prudent in our spending, which means less travel and conferences for all the Executive Branch.

As President of the Navajo Nation, I hereby exercise my line-item veto authority pursuant to 2 N.N.C. 164(A)(17). I direct the Office of the Management and Budget to make the adjustments to the budget as needed for the line-item vetoes.

BE IT ENACTED:

SECTION 1. FINDINGS

- A. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820 (L), "[t]he Navajo Nation Council may adopt and approve supplemental appropriations to the Annual Comprehensive Budget during the fiscal year. Supplemental appropriations of General Funds within the current fiscal year are permitted, if and when additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections are projected and which are also in excess of the reserve amount set forth at § 820(J)."
- B. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 164 (A)(9), a proposed resolution that requires final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be assigned to the Naabik'íyáti' Committee before it is heard by the Navajo Nation Council.
- C. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 300 (C)(1)(3) and (4) the Budget and Finance Committee is authorized to recommend adoption of resolutions related to the expenditure of the Nation's financial resources.
- D. Pursuant to 2 N.N.C. § 501 (C)(1), the Resources and Development Committee is the oversight committee for the Division of Natural Resources.

- E. The Title 12 Finance Act Supplemental Appropriation requirements include:
1. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(M), all requests for annual operating funds and supplemental funds shall be submitted to the Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") for budget impact analysis. On October 27, 2015, the Office of Management and Budget presented its memorandum with regard to this supplemental request for appropriation. The memorandum is attached as Exhibit A.
 2. Pursuant to 12 N.N.C. § 820(L), when the Controller identifies additional sources of revenues above and beyond the initial or current revenue projections, supplemental appropriations may be allocated by the Navajo Nation Council. The attached memorandum, Exhibit B, dated October 12, 2015, from the Office of the Controller has identified the additional revenues.
- F. The Navajo Nation finds it in the best interest to approve Supplemental Appropriation for \$1,786,340.00 for stipends for the District Grazing Committee, Eastern Navajo Land Board, and Major Irrigation Farm Boards.


SECTION 2. APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FROM THE UNRESERVED, UNDESIGNATED FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,786,340.00 FOR STIPENDS FOR THE DISTRICT GRAZING COMMITTEE, EASTERN NAVAJO LAND BOARD AND MAJOR IRRIGATION FARM BOARDS

- A. The Navajo Nation Council, having received certification by the Office of the Controller of the availability of certain funds from the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance (UUFB) for supplemental appropriation hereby approves the supplemental appropriation of \$1,786,340.00 for stipends for the Division of Natural Resources, District Grazing Committee, Eastern Navajo Land Board, and Major Irrigation Farm Boards as further described in budget documents attached as Exhibit C.
- B. This supplemental appropriation of \$1,786,340.00 shall be from that amount of funds that exceeds the minimum fund balance of the UUFB.





SUBJECT : **Document No. 004881:** Supplemental Funding Request for Division of Natural Resources/District Grazing Committee, BU#115002 for \$897,960; DNR/Eastern Navajo Land Board, BU#115005 for \$373,980; and DNR/Major Irrigation Farm Boards, BU#115007 for \$514,400; for a grand total of **\$1,786,340** to attend chapter and planning meetings and other operating expenses.

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 07-2013, the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) reviewed the proposed document and deems the document to be insufficient based on the following:

1. The FY 2016 Budget Instructions Manual, Section XI, provides the policies and procedures in requesting for supplemental funds. These requirements should be followed. The Supplemental Fund Proposal Summary, Appendix "K" should be included in the packet.
2. Paragraph "L" of the FY 2016 budget resolution, CS-39-15, directs the respective Branch Chief to prioritize the unmet needs. The OP/VP should do this for all Executive Branch proposals.
3. See marked-up budgets, attached, for needed corrections. The budgets should be prorated for the remaining months of the fiscal year.
4. According to the Controller, the Unreserved, Undesignated Fund Balance is currently at \$4,306,679. Last week the Navajo Nation Council approved appropriations exceeding the available balance by more than \$1,500,000. Again, prioritization of additional needs from all Branches and Divisions should be done before allocations are made.
5. There are about 25 other proposals for supplemental funding in the review process. The total is over \$25,000,000. There is not sufficient funding for these proposals.
6. Navajo Nation Code, Title 3, Sections 67 (Farm Boards), 240 (Land Boards), and 878 (Grazing Officials) states that funds, including stipends, are subject to the availability of funds.
7. Why did the Division of Natural Resources and Executive Branch not fully fund these programs? This is a continuing practice.

This amount reflects the Chapter Planning meeting stipends and mileage reimbursement for all the elected officials listed in the categories above.
