TYPE OF BURNING: Programmatic Pile/Slash Burning


PURPOSE OF BURNING PROJECT: Burn dead debris slash created from treated Russian Olives/Tamarisk Projects.

REMARKS: The recent weather in Ft. Defiance, Arizona is favorable to conduct a programmatic bum/control type burning in form of piles from previous projects. The purpose of this activity is to reduce the potential of catastrophic wildfires and to create defensible space to protect the Ft. Defiance Community and lead to more diverse ecosystem that is healthy and sustainable ecosystem.
