ONNSFA Providing Limited Services Through April 3

All Offices Closed to the Public to Deter Spread of COVID-19

WINDOW ROCK, Ariz. – The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship & Financial Assistance (ONNSFA) will provide limited services until April 3, 2020 to prevent the potential spread of COVID-19 in compliance with Executive Order 001-20.

During this time, all offices will be closed to the public. However, operations will continue on a limited basis at all agency offices from 8 am to 2 pm. Students may experience extended wait times when calling offices due to the temporary reduction of staff. Questions or concerns may be emailed to the agency offices.
