## What are Public Hearings?

The Department for Self Reliance (DSR) will be conducting Public Hearings to present and obtain public input on the Navajo Nation's Tribal Family Assistance Plan (TFAP) for the period of October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2018.

## Why is DSR conducting Public Hearings?

To increase awareness about the DSR TFAP for the Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) program.

To communicate and clarify the changes to the new TFAP.

To collect comments that may improve the new TFAP.

To collect comments to improve the Navajo Nation's TANF program.

The DSR is encouraging the public to participate and provide comments at the Public Hearings in regards to the changes of the proposed three-year TFAP for the TANF program. *(The comments from the public will be recorded and transcribed to generate a report for the Administration for Children and Families (ACF)).*

## What is the TFAP?

The TFAP outlines and defines how the Navajo Nation plans to provide TANF assistance and services, including eligibility criteria, service area, work participation requirements, approved work activities, support services, and sanctions for noncompliance.

Tribes that want to continue to operate their own Tribal TANF programs are required to submit a new TFAP every three (3) years. The Tribal TANF Regulations (45CFR Part 286) requires tribes to obtain public comments on the tribe's TFAP prior to submittal to the ACF.
