Requirements:

- Dogs must be on a leash and cats must be in carriers or pillowcases, with owners accompanying pets at all times.
- Cash Only & Please have correct change.
- All Puppies and Kittens must be 8 weeks of age or older for vaccinations and surgeries.
- July 12, 2017, Surgeries will be performed that day.
- Prior to scheduling of surgery all pets must be vaccinated. If pet was already vaccinated prior to site, bring proof of vaccinations with receipts or pet vaccination records.
- Surgeries will be scheduled on TUESDAY and performed on WEDNESDAY (CHECK-IN TIME 8:00 AM, PICK-UP TIME WILL BE ANNOUNCED AT TIME OF DROP OFF OF THE PET). All surgeries will be performed with proof of vaccination on the Navajo Nation Veterinary Mobile Unit.
- If client fails to bring in scheduled animal for that scheduled surgery Wednesday the voucher will become null and void after that scheduled date. Which client will forfeit the \$45.00 paid for spay/neuter surgery.
