COUNCIL TO HEAR AUDIT REPORT IN SPECIAL SESSION FRIDAY

The Navajo Nation Council is scheduled to meet in a special session to hear the nation's audit report from KPMG, LLP on Friday, August 25, beginning at 10 a.m. at the Council Chamber in Window Rock, Ariz.

The Ethics and Rules Committee adopted the agenda, as recommended by Speaker Lawrence T. Morgan, for tomorrow's session during a special committee meeting today.

The purpose of the session is to consider Legislation No. 0650-06, the audit report of KPMG, LLP on the primary government combined financial statements of the Navajo Nation of and for the year ending September 20, 2005.

Navajo Nation Controller Mark Grant said that every year the Navajo Nation has an audit performed of the whole Navajo Nation government.

"We know it's a long undertaking, however, it's important for the Navajo Nation to have an audit to make sure our books are in order," Grant said during the

committee meeting.

Also at the Ethics and Rules Committee meeting was John Kennedy from KPMG, LLP.
