**21st Navajo Nation Council seek to educate themselves during
two-day work sessions scheduled for June 7-8, 2007**

WINDOW ROCK, Ariz. – Members of the 21st Navajo Nation Council are scheduled to participate in a Navajo Nation Council Work Session scheduled for June 7-8, 2007 at the Holiday Inn in Gallup, N.M.

The meetings are closed to the public, and are scheduled to be formatted as executive session meetings for the council delegates.

The work session is scheduled to begin during the morning of Thursday, June 7, the council members will learn about a number of litigation cases involving the Navajo Nation. The session is scheduled to end during the afternoon.

The work session for Friday, June 8 is scheduled to begin during the morning. The session is scheduled to be completed during the afternoon.

Cases range from natural resources, the Navajo Nation and the Hopi Tribe, gaming, human services and government and tax.

The two-day work sessions are intended to inform council delegates in order to prepare each of them for their various work projects and commitments.
