Delegate Otto Tso (Tó Nanees Dizi) was selected as Chair and Delegate Raymond Smith, Jr. (Houck, Klagetoh, Nahat'a Dziil, Tsé Si'áni, Wide Ruins) was selected as Vice Chair.
