“4th Annual Shoe Game Tournament hosted by the Navajo Nation Museum”

Window Rock, AZ - December 13, 2011 - The Navajo Nation Museum invites the public to experience their 4th Annual Shoe Game Tournament during New Year’s Eve. Games begin, Saturday, December 31st, 2011 at 7:00 p.m.

The Shoe Game is a popular traditional Navajo game which is played only in the winter months. It is a guessing game played by two teams. Navajo songs are sung while an individual member from each team is making their guess. Come and join the Navajo Nation Museum staff for a night of laughter and songs.

While the Shoe Game competition is in session, other activities such as: string games, coyote stories videos, door prizes every hour, food concession, and KTNN live broadcast countdown to 2012 will be taking place at the Museum during the Shoe Game.

The event is free to the public with the exception of food concession and a team fee. If you are entering a team into the Shoe Game Tournament you must register with the Museum. Call Char Kruger at 928-810-8536 for more registration information. Entry fee is \$50 (limit of eight teams only). Prizes to be given to the first and second place teams.
