The 2021 Navajo Nation Agency Job Fairs aim to promote employment opportunities, provide departmental information, and refer submitted applications to the appropriate departments for assessment. The general public and community members are welcome to attend, apply and may refer to the DPM website for additional resources such as the Navajo Nation Employment Application, current Job Vacancy Listing, and external employment opportunities.

Applicants are encouraged to complete the Navajo Nation Employment Application and bring the completed form to one of the job fairs along with a valid state driver's license, Certificate of Indian Blood, and other documents outlined in the attached flyer. Upon receipt, the Department of Personnel Management shall verify completed packets, log-in, and forward to the respective department for assessment and/or interviews.

The Office of Background Investigations, Navajo Department of Workforce Development, Navajo Head Start, Navajo Nation Emergency Medical Services, and Navajo Police Department-Recruitment will be onsite to provide supplemental information and answer questions. Additionally, applications and on-site copying services will be available at each venue.

All attendees must adhere to COVID-19 safety protocols such as wearing a face mask, temperature screening, social distancing, and other safety measures. In addition, attendees are highly encouraged to be fully vaccinated.
