Navajo President Joe Shirley, Jr., signs off on \$4.5 million for White Cone Multipurpose Facility Project to continue

WINDOW ROCK, Ariz. – Navajo Nation President Joe Shirley, Jr., today signed documents to provide \$4.5 million for construction of the White Cone Multipurpose Facility Project.

Chapter President Hanley thanked the President on behalf of the chapter and said plans are now underway for a restaurant and motel next to the multipurpose facility.

The project has been a dream of the community since 1996.

Witnessing the signing was Council Delegate Lee Jack, White Cone Chapter President Bennie Hanley, Sr., architect Cal Thomason of LAM Corporation, and contractors Oran Arviso and Orville Arviso of Arviso Construction.

The 17,727 square-foot facility will provide space for indoor recreation, community gatherings, meetings and offices for tribal and government programs. Total cost for the project is \$5 million. Navajo AML Reclamation Department provided \$300,000 for site preparation.

“It makes my heart glad to see it,” President Shirley said. “And working together, it’s the only way to be. It gives great pleasure to sign off on this, and let the work continue.”
