### **ONNSFA Offices Remain Closed to Public Until May 17; Limited Services Provided at Agency Offices**

WINDOW ROCK, Ariz. – The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship & Financial Assistance (ONNSFA) will continue providing limited services through May 17 with reduced staff and office hours. All offices will remain closed to the public for in-person services to safeguard staff and students.

Navajo Nation President Jonathan Nez and Vice President Myron Lizer issued Executive Order 003-20 on Tuesday, extending the declaration of a state of emergency and extending the closure of Navajo Nation government offices and related entities until May 17, to help slow and reduce the spread of COVID-19 on the Navajo Nation. The previous Executive Order was set to expire on April 26.
