

Navajo Education Incentive, formerly known as The Navajo School Clothing Program, Now Accepting Applications

The Navajo Family Assistance Services (NFAS) was established on January 8, 2020, and is located within the Department for Self Reliance (DSR) to provide the Navajo Education Incentive (NEI), formerly known as the Navajo School Clothing Program.

The NEI provides financial assistance to eligible school age Navajo children to purchase clothing or school supplies in an effort to promote school attendance, support academic performance and support confidence.

Who is eligible?

In order to determine eligibility for NEI, the following requirements must be met:

- The Child must be between the ages of 3 to 17 years of age on the date of the application.
- The Child is an enrolled member of the Navajo Nation.
- The Child is enrolled in a school located on the Navajo Nation.
- The Child must be attending Head-Start, Pre-Kindergarten, Preschool and grades K through 12.
- Children receiving the DSR's School Clothing Incentive are not eligible for NEI.

What should I bring when I apply?

- The Child's Certificate of Indian Blood;
- The Child's valid Social Security Card;
- A document on official school letterhead verifying the child is enrolled.
- Applicant must sign a W-9.

Due to COVID-19 precautions, the DSR is not allowing the public into offices.
