Applications are available for Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)

Applications for Assistance for Fiscal Year 2021 must be submitted by 9/1/2021 or until funds are depleted

To apply you will need:

- Driver's License or Photo ID of applicant.
- Social Security cards for all household members.
- Certificate of Indian Blood or verification of Tribal Enrollment for all household members.
- Proof of income for all household members over the age 18.
- Proof of residency: Chapter Residence form, or Household Composition form - filled out by someone who knows you. You must be a resident of the Navajo Nation.
- A detailed map of residence, with a description of home.
- A recent utility, electric, natural gas, or propane bill, with applicants name and account number, dated no more than 30 days prior to application.
- Original invoice or quote(s) from vendor(s), with applicant's name and account number. Weatherization requires three quotes from three different vendors.
- Households that received LIHEAP in prior years, must provide receipts totaling the full amount of assistance. These receipts must be accounted for in full to be eligible for LIHEAP assistance. Receipts must be submitted within 30 days.

All documents, receipts, invoices and quotes must match applicant's name. LIHEAP assistance is available once per fiscal year. If you receive similar assistance, you will not be eligible for LIHEAP.
